There is a special doggie area for you to do your business, just outside around the parking lot...also, you may have noticed some of our rooms have a patio, you can use that too, but make sure your people always clean up after you! There are always more doggie bag! **Please do not use the courtyard.**
6. Oh and goodness – if you have an accident in the room (heaven forbid), have your people clean it up as much as possible and **call our people right away! Please have your owners use toilet paper or paper towels to clean up any messes!** We have a special cleaning product to eliminate stains and odors.
7. When you take your owner out for a walk, remember to be on your leash and have your people bring the scooper bags! Sedona is a very pet friendly city. Lots of stores and restaurants will let you in or on their patio, and they always have a bowl of welcoming water out for you!
